### Objective :

To collect or update data on the vulnerability context by identifying the impact of inequities on men and women's associations

What changes have you noticed in the last 3 last years? (list of contextual factors)

Who were those who helped in improving your livelihoods? (opportunities)

Who are those who made life difficult for you?
